Honeybell Announcement Postcards

HoneyBell Announcement Cards are available to be sent to your Mini Honeybell & Golden Honeybell Recipients. We will start printing and mailing the Honeybell Announcement Cards around 12/15/24. All non-buyer HoneyBell recipients will receive a card. Unfortunately, there is no way to restrict any cards for certain recipients.

The cost for this service is \$0.18 per card, plus First Class postage at \$0.56 each for a total of \$0.74 per card. You will be billed based upon number of cards printed.

** The first available week for arrival will be 1/13/25. This allows us to monitor the crop after the New Year and control the quality. Pushing this availability window forward a week, will not affect the availability and shipping of all other varieties.

Standard & Expedited Shipping

Standard Delivery:

ASAP Orders received by Monday at 6:00 PM EST will be processed to ship that same week for arrival the following week.

Federal Express Delivery:

All Orders requesting expedited delivery service must be in our hands by 10:00 AM EST in order to ship same day.

All orders must have a physical address, No PO Boxes.

Canada Delivery:

Shipping begins November thru May. Delivery takes approximately 2-3 days via FedEx 2-Day Air Service only.

Shipping will be once per week with cutoff at 6 pm Monday to arrive the same week.

Additional upcharge of \$32.00 per package.

No PO Box addresses.

Alaska & Hawaii Delivery:

All orders must have a physical address and will be shipped FedEx 2-3 day.

Citrus cannot be shipped into Hawaii.

Fruit Varieties & Descriptions

<u>Golden Honeybell</u> (Mid Jan - Mar) Medium to large fruit, bell shaped. Fragrant and bursting with sweet juice, this hard-to-find citrus is a unique cross between the richly flavored Mandarin and honey-sweet Grapefruit. These sunset-orange treats are quite rare—harvested January through March.

<u>Honeybell</u> (Mid Feb - April) Medium fruit, bell shaped. Hybrid between a Dancy tangerine and a Duncan grapefruit. Tangy sweet and very juicy with few seeds. These will be from our California groves.

<u>Honey Sweet Tangerines</u> (Nov - May) Smaller and less rounded than common oranges. They are thin skinned and easy to peel. Slightly soft with pebbly skin and orange in color. They have a sweet and stronger taste.

<u>Navel</u> (Mid Nov - May) Large to extra-large fruit, deep yellow to orange in color with easy to peel skin. They get there name from the navel appearance on the bottom of the fruit. The "Second Orange" is what helps the navel to be seedless.

<u>Red Navel</u> (Jan - April) Deep red flesh, sweet and mild with extraordinary flavor and abundant juice.

Baby O Mandarins (Dec - Jan) Mandarin orange that is easy to peel and full of flavor.

<u>Temple</u> (Feb) Tangy and sweet with pebbled, reddish – orange skin that is easy to peel. It is a cross between a sweet orange and a tangerine.

<u>Deep Red (Crimson) Grapefruit</u> (Nov - Jan) Deep red flesh with a darker blush colored skin. Rich in flavor and sweet.

Ruby Red Grapefruit (Nov - May) Plump and thin skinned with blushing red flesh. They are seedless and easy to peel.

White Grapefruit (Nov - Jan) Sweet and tart flesh with a smooth thin skin.
